The NGER scheme is a piece of national legislation that requires companies which trip the reporting thresholds to submit their Scope 1 and Scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions, energy production and energy consumption.



NGER thresholds:
25,000 t CO₂-e or 100 TJ for facilities
50,000 t CO₂-e or 200 TJ for corporations



Informs Government policy, the Australian public and help Australia meet international reporting obligations



Important dates:
Registration: 31st August
Submission: 31st October
